The Vision Exhibition Award – 2023:

Do you have a visionary exhibition idea?

The Bikuben Foundation would like to invite independent curators, art centers and venues, museums and others who work professionally with exhibitions to submit entries for the 2023 Vision Exhibition Award. Entries can be submitted between 20 February and 6 March 2023.

Every year, the Bikuben Foundation invites independent curators, art centers and venues, museums, and other professionals within visual arts to realize a visionary exhibition concept with contemporary relevance.

The recipient receives up to 5 million kroner to move their exhibition from concept to reality and is invited to participate in workshops that can develop concepts for communication of the exhibition idea.

The Bikuben Foundation offers the Vision Exhibition Award as a way to give professionals working with visual-arts exhibitions a free space to innovate exhibition formats.

"Our aim is to contribute to the creation of new opportunities for curators and art institutions by supporting visionary concepts and ideas. It is important to us that the Vision Exhibition Award has relevance for the entire visual-arts field, and we hope that we again this year will see innovative exhibition ideas from both established as well as independent professionals," says Mette Marcus, Director, The Bikuben Foundation.



About the Vision Exhibition Award

- The Vision Exhibition Award is given once a year by the Bikuben Foundation as a way to encourage the development of visionary and innovative exhibition formats.
- A jury consisting of professionals from relevant fields will assess all entries focusing on how innovative the format is as well as the visionary nature of the concept.
- Three ideas are invited to a second round. Those selected to go on will receive 40,000 kroner to further develop and qualify their ideas and concepts. The Bikuben Foundation can also provide access to meeting facilities and aive financial advice.
- After that, the jury gives a second assessment of the three entries selected, before finally selecting the recipient of the Vision Exhibition Award, who receives up to 5 million kroner to realize the exhibition in Denmark.
- The Vision Exhibition Award was established in 2014 with the intention of encouraging exhibition professionals to develop new ideas and formats.
